We've had a joyous and productive month here at GCSRW, and we're excited to share some of our recent activities:

- We attended the Council of Bishops gathering and hosted a luncheon for the women bishops. We also celebrated the election of Bishop Tracy S. Malone as the new president of the Council of Bishops, taking office in 2024. She is the first Black woman to be elected to lead more than 110 bishops in the global denomination that includes Africa, Asia, Europe and Americas.
- Our staff convened with other leaders across the connection to lay the groundwork for our participation at General Conference to be held in Charlotte, NC in 2024. Expect more detailed information on this soon.
- We also led a Response Team training session for the Oregon/Idaho Annual Conference, contributing to enhancing preparedness and support within their own context.
- Finally, we will be spearheading a workshop on *Healthy Boundaries, Healthy Churches* at the Facing the Future event, organized by the General Commission on Religion and Race.
