#### WHAT DOES IT DO?

Determines whether decisions by other United Methodist bodies are legal and/or constitutional.

#### **MEMBERS**

- 9 total
- · 4 clergy and 4 laity
- 1 seat alternating between clergy and lay every 8 years
- Nominated by Council of Bishops or General Conference delegates
- Elected by General Conference

### **COUNCIL SESSIONS**

- Held twice a year in spring and fall
- Convened before and during General Conference





#### WHAT DOES THE COUNCIL CONSIDER?

- Petitions from the Council of Bishops
- Petitions from the General Conference and central, jurisdictional and annual conferences
- · All decisions of law made by bishops
- · Appeals of decisions of lower church courts

## **WHAT HAPPENS AFTER A RULING?**

- · Decisions are final.
- · Involved parties are informed.
- Rulings are posted online.
- · If necessary The Book of Discipline is revised
